Background

The COVID-19 pandemic is rapidly spreading across the globe and threatens to derail HIV, TB, and malaria programs, overwhelm community and health systems and cause significant morbidity and mortality. To mitigate the impact of the pandemic on the three diseases and support health and community systems in the Republic of South Africa, SABCOHA will be implementing COVID-19 response focusing in two Metros i.e. Buffalo City Metro and eThekweni Metro. The main focus of this program is provide support to the Informal Traders in these two metros. This post requires two enrolled nurses who resides either in the Eastern Cape or Kwa-Zulu Natal province. This will be a 9-12 months contract in line with the duration of the grant

Responsibilities

- Screen and test members of Informal Traders and Waster Pickers Association on HIV/AIDS/TB and Covid-19
- Record and report all cases to the project manager
- Refer clients who appear symptomatic to the public health facilities
- Evaluate potential problems and technical hitches and report them to the project manager
- Plan and manage team goals, project schedules and new information
- Coordinate the project and keep the workflow on track
- Manage project-related paperwork by ensuring all necessary materials are current, properly filed and stored
- Direct project correspondences by preparing and reviewing requests to the PM
