- Provide follow up care and support.
- Provide support, mentorship & technical support to SSR team members.
- Facilitate Health and Gender Based Violence Dialogues for men in workplaces and communities.
- Work with the Strategic Information team to ensure all program related data is collected accurately and timeously and ensure collected data is utilised to inform and redirect program implementation.
- Assist Data team during monitoring and verification visits.
- Assist in other related responsibilities as assigned by the provincial manager.
